

Dettmann urges District IV voters to make a change

Popular activist mails 3,500 letters expressing great disappointment with Cindi Hutchinson's performance

RAY DETTMANN wants District IV voters to put new blood on the City Commission because Cindi Hutchinson is "not the person we elected. She's out of touch. She's pro-development. She's lost sight of who she serves."

Dettmann is president of Harbordale and Past President of Poinciana Park. He is a well-liked figure in the District and has supported Cindi in the past.

"I'm mad as hell about what's going on in our city. We need new blood on the City Commission. I'm voting for Charles Jordan," he wrote in a letter to District IV voters.
